

# OUR PROGRAMS



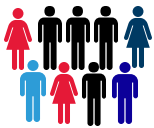
